PELL (www.fafsa.ed.gov) codes are provided upon applying for the FAFSA/PELL grant. Participants must apply for a PELL grant per the Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board’s local policy. Applying for a PELL grant may give you additional training funds. This is a grant – not a loan. If you are awarded a PELL grant, it does not need to be repaid but must be applied first, before the WIOA program financial assistance.

Not all providers listed above are PELL eligible. Those that are must meet the specific PELL requirements.

Those individuals who have a Bachelor’s Degree are not PELL eligible and must obtain a statement from the training provider indicating PELL ineligibility.
